The most contaminated pet food results in glyphosate exposure that, at the high end, is **roughly 25% above the average** daily intake for humans.

Overall, dogs are shown to have roughly **32 times higher** levels of glyphosate than the human average, with cats showing 16 times the human average.

With this gut-damaging chemical so prevalent in the world around us, it's hard to know where to turn.
